Driver's Education Program
Summer 2017
(1/2 Carnegie Unit)

On behalf of the Madison County School System we are glad to be hosting the 2017 Summer Driver's Education Program at Sparkman 9th Grade School. The class is made up of 2 sections; classroom instruction and actual driving experience.

Students will be required to attend all 5 days of the classroom instruction and a minimum of 3 days of scheduled driving times. At the conclusion of the classroom instruction, each student will drive/ride three consecutive days as assigned (1.5 hours per day). Driving groups will be determined by the instructor on the first day of each session. The students are only responsible to be on campus during their 1.5 hour driving/riding time once that portion begins.

SPACE IS LIMITED AND SEATS WILL BE FILLED ON A FIRST COME BASIS

- Registration: June 1st and June 2nd, 8:00-3:00 @ Sparkman 9 Campus for the first 45 students
- Fee: \$120 for students attending any Madison County School
 \$145 for out of district students
- The following are required at the time of registration:
 1. Copy of driving permit
 2. Registration fee in cash, personal check, cashier's check or money order made payable to: Sparkman 9th Grade School
- All classes will be held on the Sparkman 9th Grade Campus in the small auditorium

- No credit will be awarded to any student missing more than 1 day of instruction, regardless of reason. Checkouts and tardies count as missed time. Students who exceed this time will be dismissed without refund or credit. No make-up hours will be scheduled. Any student dismissed due to disciplinary reasons will also be dismissed without any credit or refund.
- Student driving time is based on time needed for the demonstration of proficiency of skills.
- Students will be given the opportunity to take their AL license test if no class time is missed.
- Students must bring their lunch, including a drink, on days they are in the classroom. Vending machines are available.
